



## **Standard Chartered KL Marathon (SCKLM) 2018**

### **Pacer Application Terms and Conditions**

#### General

- You must be 21 years old or older as of Event day to apply as a volunteer pacer.

#### Duty

- Your role is to act as pace markers for runners to follow in order to achieve a particular finishing time, e.g. if you are a 4:30 hour pacer, you have to forgo your personal best and fully focus on serving and pacing the runners following you in order to finish the run within said finishing time. You must be comfortable in achieving that finishing time on Race Day.
- You need to complete the run in a consistent pace with the pace group with a gun time of 30 seconds to 1 minute ahead of the pace group timing.
- You also need to complete the run attired in the official pacer's singlet, shorts and shoes (and other sponsored products if any) with a balloon attached to you, and wear your own running watch.

#### Benefits

As a volunteer pacer, you will be entitled to the following benefits:

- Free entry to SCKLM 2018
- A Race Entry Pack (kindly self-collect during REPC like other public runners)
- Free entry to SCKLM 2018 Friendship Run and Pasta Party
- A pacer's singlet from Brooks
- Sponsored shorts and shoes from Brooks
- Featured on SCKLM website and Facebook

#### Sponsored Apparel and Shoes

- All pacers will receive a singlet, a pair of shorts and shoes. It is compulsory for you to wear them throughout the entire run on Race Day.
- Should you choose to withdraw from the pacer team after you have received the sponsored products, you must return the products to the Organiser immediately.
- Once you have received the products, please wear them during your long run training to break them in before Race Day.

#### Pacer Briefing and Assessment

It is mandatory for all pacers to attend the pacer briefing & assessment sessions conducted by Mark Williams which are scheduled to be held as follows;

### Pacer Kit Presentation

There will be a pacer kit presentation event which will be held at a Brooks store in March. Although attendance is optional, we strongly advise you to attend as any discrepancy in the size of your shoes or apparel can be attended to immediately by representatives from Brooks. ### Communication

- We have a 'Pacer page' on our website and feature all pacers on our Facebook page.
- You will have an individual profile page on our website, and you can share your page on your Facebook account telling your running friends to follow you on Race Day.

### Race Day

- You are required to attend a briefing and photography session on 8 April 2018 at the Information Tent, Dataran Merdeka. Full marathon pacers must arrive by 3:00 am while the half marathon pacers must arrive by 4:30 am. A pacer's bib and balloon will be given to you after the briefing.
- You are required to motivate fellow runners and run with the balloon attached to you during the entire run. The pacer's bib must be pinned on the back of your singlet.

### Protecting the Organiser's reputation

All pacers are the Event's ambassadors and must promote a positive image at all times. Discrimination or prejudice of any kind, whether based upon political beliefs and/or activities, race, disability, colour, religion, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, or age is prohibited.

### Indemnity and Release Agreement

By submitting this application,

- I affirm that the facts set forth in this application form are true, accurate, current and complete.
- I understand that if I am accepted as a volunteer pacer, any false information, omissions, or other misrepresentations made by me on this application may result in my immediate dismissal.
- I agree to wear and fully endorse the official pacer's apparel and shoes from the Organiser only.
- I warrant that I have completed at least two recent road races with published results that can be verified.
- I agree to the commitments and responsibilities I must fulfil, and I agree to protect the Event's reputation, which failing to do so will result in my immediate dismissal and full confiscation of my sponsored pacer apparel and shoes.
- I agree that the Organiser reserves the right to select pacers and assign me to any pace group as it deems fit. I understand that the Organiser reserves the right to re-assign my pace group should the need arise.
- I agree that I am participating as a volunteer pacer at my own risk, including but not limited to serious injury or even death from various causes including over exertion, dehydration and accidents with other volunteer pacers, runners, spectators or road users. I voluntarily assume all risks associated with my entry application and participation as a pacer in the Event or any



activity associated with it. I consent to receiving any medical treatment that the Organiser thinks necessary during or after the Event.

- I, the undersigned, in consideration of and as a condition of acceptance of my entry as a volunteer pacer for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns, release the Organiser, officers, its agents, affiliates, employees, members, sponsors, partners, promoters and any person or other body directly or indirectly associated with the Event, from all claims, demands and proceedings arising out of or in connection with my participation as a volunteer pacer and I indemnify them against all liability (including acts of negligence to the fullest extent permitted by law) whatsoever and howsoever caused arising as a result of or in connection with my participation as a volunteer pacer including any loss whatsoever of personal property or otherwise.
- I will abide by the Event Rules and Regulations, Terms and Conditions and other rules and timelines, as varies from time to time and will accept that the Organiser has discretion to accept or decline any entry on whatever grounds.

All other Rules and Regulations for the Standard Chartered KL Marathon as stipulated on the website apply.
